

# Knitted bracelets

**STEP BY STEP 023**

## Knitted bracelets



**01** Cut 2 pcs. of thick thread of 60cm. in different colours and 1 pce of 25cm of the thin. □ Gather them and glue them in a end cap. Use super glue.



**02** Now plaid 5 knots as shown. Always use the thread that faces your body.



**03** Now put a bead on the thin threa in the middle. □ Keep on knitting 5 more knots. It has to be an uneven number for the colour to change from side to side. □ Continue until the bracelet fits. Remember to include the lock.



**04** To gather the ends when they are glued in the end cap, you can weld them together with a lighter. Mount an oval ring on each side and a lock in one of the sides.
