



## A Christmas Bauble from Faux Leather Paper Star Strips

STEP BY STEP 023  
Inspiration: 14980



Cut both star strip into three 26 cm pieces. Make holes in both ends and in the middle of all six pieces using a needle or punch pliers. □

Cut a 50 cm piece of leather cord. Tie two knots approx. in the middle – the distance between the knots measures approx. 7 cm. Thread a wooden bead onto each cord end and push them down to the knots.

Thread the star strips onto the cord through the middle hole in the star strips.

Assemble the bauble. Thread all the paper strips onto the cord from the bottom. Finish with a knot.

Thread wooden beads and a jewellery pendant onto the cord. Feed the cord end back through the beads and the knot and tie another knot.

## A Christmas Bauble from Faux Leather Paper Star Strips

You will need two faux leather paper star strips for this bauble as well as a leather cord. Cut each star strip into three pieces and assemble all the pieces around the leather cord. □

Tighten the cord and trim the end.
