## A Tray crocheted from Cotton Tube Yarn

Crochet your very own tray from cotton tube yarn. The diameter of the finished cotton tuby yarn tray is approx. 25.5 cm . Materials: 200 g cotton tube yarn.

Row 1: 6 dcs in a magic ring
Row 2: 2 dcs in each cs (12)
Row 3: *1 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (18)
Row 4: *2 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (24)
Row 5: *3 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (30)
Row 6: *4 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (36)
Row 7: *5 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (42)
Row 8: *6 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (48)
Row 9: *7 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (54)
Row 10: *8 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (60)
Row 11: *9 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (66)
Row 12: *10 dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (72)
Row 13: ${ }^{*} 11 \mathrm{dcs}, 2 \mathrm{dcs}$ in the next cs* (78)
Row 14: ${ }^{*} 12$ dcs, 2 dcs in the next cs* (84)

Finish with a chain stitch and now crochet the other/ opposite way around. Crochet the next round in the back loop.
Row 15: dcs (84)
Row 16: dcs (84)
Row 17: 10 dcs, 10 cs, skip 10 st, 32 dcs, 10 cs, skip 10 st, 22 dcs (84)
Row 18: dcs (84)

Dcs = Double crochet
Cs = Chain stitch
St $=$ stitch
