A crocheted mistletoe

No. 2.5 crochet hook

Stalk

- 1: Chain 40, 50 or 60 ch (different lengths of stalks, min. 2 of each)
- 2: Tie the yarn end from the start of the chain onto one end of the metal wire.
- 3: Now crochet dc through ch around the metal wire all the way to the other end of the metal wire.

Leaf/leaves

crochet these at the end of the stalk – crochet 2 or 3 leaves

- 1: Chain 14 ch
- 2: Crochet 3 x trtr in the 6th st from the hook.

 Crochet 1 x trtr in both of the next two st.

 Crochet 1 x tr in each of the next three st and 1 x dc in the each of the following 3 st.
- 3: Fasten the leaf onto the stalk with 2 dc
- 4: Repeat 1.-3. once or twice, depending on whether you want two or three leaves on the stalk.

You may crochet the leaves onto the middle of the stalk instead.

Berry/berries

- 1: 6 dc in a magic ring **(6)**
- 2: dc in all st **(6)**
- 3: 2 dc tog x 3

Bind off, feed the yarn end through the berry and through the magic ring using the crochet hook. Crochet one or two berries per stalk.

Ribbon

- 1: Chain 140 ch
- 2: Push the crochet hook through the second st from the hook. Crochet 140 dc back. Bind off.

Trim the length of the metal wire with pliers and bend into an organic shape.

Secure the ends, sew on the berries and tie the bouquet with the ribbon
