


Crocheted miniature Christmas stocking



UK magic ring **DK/NO/SE** magisk ring
FI taikarengas **NL** magische ring
DE Magischer Ring **FR** anneau magique
ES Anillo mágico **IT** anello magico.



UK double crochet **DK/NO** fastmaske
SE fast maska **FI** kintead silmukka
NL dubbel gehaakt **DE** Stäbchen
FR maille serrée **ES** punto alto
IT maglia alta.



UK chain stitch **DK/NO** luftmaske
SE luftmaska **FI** ketjusilmukka
NL jasseronsteek **DE** Luftmasche
FR maille en l'air **ES** punto de cadena
IT punto catenella.

Needle no. 3

- 1: magic ring with 6 dc (**6**)
- 2: 2 dc in each stitch (**12**)
- 3: 12 dc around the piece (**12**)
- 4: *1 dc, 2 dc* repeat for the whole round (**18**)
- 5-10: 18 dc around the piece

Now crochet the heel over 10 sts with turns, the others are rests.

- 11: 10 dc, turn
- 12: Skip 1 stitch, 9 dc, turn
- 13: Skip 1 stitch, 8 dc, turn
- 14: Skip 1 stitch, 7 dc, turn
- 15: Skip 1 stitch, 6 dc, turn
- 16: Skip 1 stitch, 5 dc, turn
- 17: Skip 1 stitch, 4 dc, turn
- 18: Crochet 3 dc up along the edge, 8 dc on the forefoot, 3 dc up along the edge, 4 dc on heel edge (**18**)
- 19-26: 18 rounds in dc around the piece. We recommend that you finish off the last round at the back of the sock, i.e. 3-4 extra stitches, as this gives a nicer result

Cut the red yarn and weave in the ends

- 27-28: start at the back of the sock with white and crochet 2 rounds in white (**18**)
- 29: for example, crochet 10 chain stitches to the hanging loop, cut and weave in the end. If longer loop is desired, add more ch.

Abbreviations and symbol explanations

- dc = double crochet
ch = chain stitch
* = repeat from * to * for the whole the round
