# A crocheted sitting elephant 

This small sitting elephant with tusks is crocheted from $100 \%$ cotton yarn using a No. 3 crochet hook. The elephant is filled with polyester stuffing.

## Head

| 12: | * $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc} \operatorname{tog}^{*} \mathbf{( 1 8 )}$ |
| 13: | * $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ tog* (12) |

## Body

## Leg $\times 4$

1:

3: $\quad 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in the back loop (12)
4: $\quad$ * $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ tog $^{*}$ (10)
5-6: $\quad 1 \mathrm{dc}(\mathbf{1 0})$

Break the yarn and fill the legs with a bit of polyester stuffing. Sew the legs onto the body.

## Ear x 2

| 1: | 6 dc in a magic ring (6) |

| 2: | 2 dc in each crochet stitch (12) |
| $3:$ | ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next crochet stitch* (18) |
| 4: | ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc} i$ in the next crochet stitch* (24) |
| 5: | ${ }^{*} 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next crochet stitch* (30) |
| Break the yarn and sew the ears onto the head. |  |

## Tusk x 2 (white)

1: $\quad 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in a magic ring (3)

2: $\quad 2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next crochet stitch (4)
3: $\quad 1 \mathrm{dc}(4)$
4: $\quad 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next crochet stitch (5)
5: $\quad 1 \mathrm{dc}$ (5)
Break the yarn and sew the tusks onto the head.

## Eye $\times 2$ (white)

1: $\quad 6 \mathrm{dc}$ in a magic ring (6)
$2: \quad 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in each crochet stitch (12)
Break the yarn and sew the eyes onto the head.

# Pupil $\times 2$ (black) 

1: $\quad 6 \mathrm{dc}$ in a magic ring (6)
Break the yarn and sew the pupils onto the eyes Secure any loose threads.
