## Body

10: *2 dc, 2 dc tog* (18)

Fill the body with polyester stuffing
12: *2 dc tog* (6)
Break the yarn, sew together the small hole and secure the end of the yarn.
Sew the head onto the body

## Leg x 4

1: 6 dc in a magic ring (6)
2: 2 dc in each crochet stitch (12)
3: 1 dc in the back loop (12)
4: \*4 dc, 2 dc tog\* (10)
5-6: 1 dc (10)

Break the yarn and fill the legs with a bit of polyester stuffing. Sew the legs onto the body.

#### Ear x 2

1: 6 dc in a magic ring (6)
2: 2 dc in each crochet stitch (12)
3: \*1 dc, 2 dc in the next crochet stitch\* (18)
4: \*2 dc, 2 dc i in the next crochet stitch\* (24)
5: \*3 dc, 2 dc in the next crochet stitch\* (30)
Break the yarn and sew the ears onto the head.

## Tusk x 2 (white)

1: 3 dc in a magic ring (3)
2: 2 dc, 2 dc in the next crochet stitch (4)
3: 1 dc (4)
4: 3 dc, 2 dc in the next crochet stitch (5)
5: 1 dc (5)
Break the yarn and sew the tusks onto the head.

## Eye x 2 (white)

6 dc in a magic ring (6)
 2 dc in each crochet stitch (12)
 Break the yarn and sew the eyes onto the head.

## Pupil x 2 (black)

1: 6 dc in a magic ring **(6)**Break the yarn and sew the pupils onto the eyes
Secure any loose threads.
