

A crocheted Dishcloth with the Crunch Stitch Style Pattern

This dishcloth is crocheted with the popular crunch stitch style pattern.
We have used cotton yarn 8/4 on No. 3.5 crochet hook.

A TIP!

In order for the dishcloths to keep the colours from fading, you may soak them in cold water with a small amount of white vinegar. This should also improve their absorbency. Wash the dishcloths before use.

Size 20 x 20 cm

You will need 20 g yarn (approx. 1/2 skein)

How to crochet the dishcloth:

Chain 36 stitches + 1 turning chain.

Row 1: crochet this row using dc

Row 2: Turn with 1 cs (turning chain). Crochet *1 dc in the first chain, 1 bs in the next chain*. Repeat from * to * till the end of the row.

Row 3: Turn with 1 cs (turning chain). Crochet *1 bs in the first chain, 1 dc in the next chain*. Repeat from * to * till the end of the row. The idea is to crochet double crochet stitches on top of the basic treble stitches of the previous row and to crochet basic treble stitches on top of all the double crochet stitches of the previous row.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until the dishcloth measures 20 cm.



Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

Cs = chain stitch

Dc = Double crochet stitch

M = Stitch

Bs = Basic treble stitch
